Recent Events in Corporate Governance in Spain. Conference given by Mrs. Maria Elvira Rodríguez Herrer, Chairwoman of the CNMV¹.

This conference is part of a series of activities aimed at bringing speakers in high positions of responsibility (as was the case with the Secretary General for the Treasury).

The head of the CNMV provided a brief analysis pointing to the fact that **one of the major causes of the financial crisis was the lack of risk control in corporate governance**, and went on to explain the main **lines of action that are scheduled to be implemented in the near future**.

A broad discussion followed this brief introduction, with a barrage of questions by the participants who took advantage of the fact that Mrs. Rodríguez did not shy away from openly answering all the questions posed.
